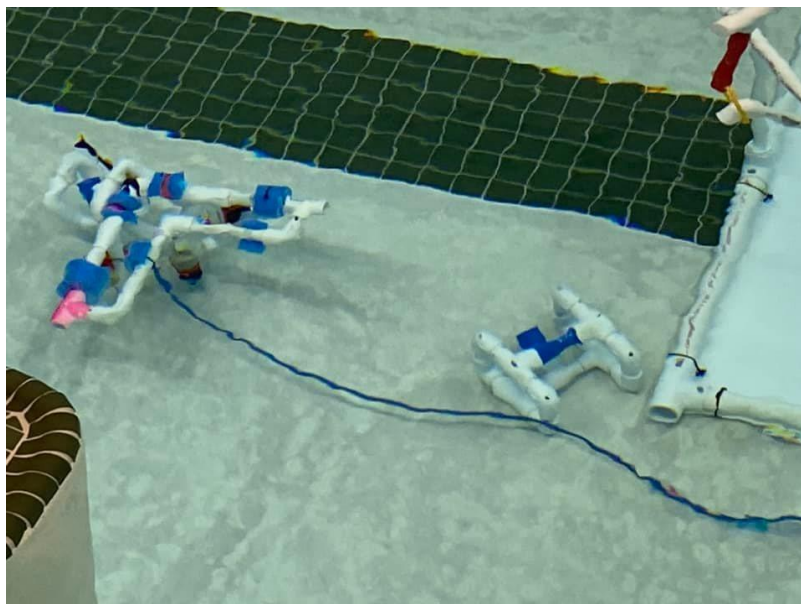


# Door County Students Place at SeaPerch Competition
